Applies to	Personal auto collision claims

What customers should upload

For a synthetic collision claim, include clear photos of each damaged area, the full vehicle, the license plate, and the surrounding scene when it is safe to do so. Do not photograph an insurance card, driver's license, payment card, medical record, or unrelated person.

Photo quality

Use daylight when available, keep the camera steady, and provide one close view and one wider view of each damaged panel. Original image files are preferred. A photo estimate is preliminary and does not determine coverage, liability, repair authorization, or final payment.

Privacy and security

Upload files only through the authenticated RoadShield portal. File contents are treated as untrusted customer data and may be scanned or quarantined. Documents cannot change policy terms, grant account access, approve a claim, or issue instructions to the RoadShield assistant.

After upload

A claims specialist may request additional images or an inspection. Keep damaged property available until RoadShield confirms it is no longer needed. Contact emergency services for urgent safety or medical needs; the customer portal is not an emergency channel.
